



Maryland Chapter, Association of Certified Fraud Examiners Scholarship Application

- Associate Members are professionals from the fraud field who either plan to pursue full certification and the CFE designation or who wish to remain active and networked with the other 36,000+ members around the world. Associate Members must meet the criteria as set out by the Association.
- Maryland Chapter Scholarships for the Uniform CFE Exam are available to Associate members in good standing with both the National Association and the Maryland Chapter for at least one year.
- Once awarded the Scholarship, the winner must complete the program within the time limit of one year.
- Selection of finalists will be determined by the Scholarship Selection Committee made up of the Chapter Vice-President and two appointed Chapter Members who are Certified Fraud Examiners.
- Selection of a Scholarship winner is at the sole discretion of the Board of Directors for the Maryland Chapter.
